Specifications

- Maximum operating pressure: up to 175 PSI
- Preset orifices restrict the volume of water thereby lowering the pressure of the flowing water; NFPA requires restricting valves where inlet pressure exceeds 100 PSI
- Restricts inlet pressure from 70 PSI up to a maximum of 175 PSI
- Restricts down to outlet pressures of 65, 80, or 100 PSI, outlet pressures may be set below 65 PSI when authorized by the local authority having jurisdiction

Application

 Used when flowing water pressure needs to be controlled

Features

- Restricting valve has no effect on the static pressure of a system
- Restricting device can be manually bypassed if required by opening the valve fully: pull the pin allowing the yoke to fall back from the valve stem, which allows valve to be fully opened. When valve needs to be restricted again, slide the yoke back into place to be NFPA compliant

Specification

 Preset orifices restrict the volume of water, thereby lowering the pressure of the flowing water; NFPA requires restricting valves where inlet pressure exceeds 100 PSI
